Welcome to the Concord Pacific Dragon Boat Festival, North America's biggest dragon boat race! Race Bulletin 1 provides information on races, logistics, and Festival services/tickets booking forms. Email info@dragonboatbc.ca with any questions.

Festival Information

Location: Concord Pacific Place, Creekside Park, and False Creek. The Festival site starts at Creekside Community Centre on the South shore, to Creekside Park on the East shore, and around the Concord Pacific Showroom on the North shore.

<u>Times</u>: Races start at 4:30 on Friday, and 8:00 AM on Saturday and Sunday.

All Access Friday: Start your weekend at All Access Friday. Grand Finals include the Survivor Showdown, CIBC Breast Cancer Ceremony (cancer survivor), and All Access Cup (charity). Enjoy International Cup seeding races and the Pure Maple Water Visiting Team Welcome. International Saturday: We celebrate different cultures and our teams from around the world. Featured Grand Finals include the Women's Guts and Glory and the Concord Pacific Champions Race Series including the International Cup.

Championship Sunday: The final day features divisional and Grand Finals. Medal Ceremonies begin on the Main Stage at 2:00 PM. Finish the Festival off at Oddball's Sunday Session at the Main Stage Beverage Garden!

Race Information

The Concord Pacific Dragon Boat Festival uses the Dragon Boat BC 2018 Official Rules and Regulations. Please visit <u>www.vancouverdragonboatfestival.ca/downloads</u> for a copy of the rules.

All races except Guts and Glory, International Cup, and All Access Cup are 500M. Races are in 20 person BuK boats. The race course is 9 lanes, and is a tidal saltwater course. Starts are free floating.

All paddlers must wear an approved PFD at all times on the docks and water. Inflatable PFDs are not allowed. Personal paddles are allowed if they meet IDBF 202a specifications. Club paddles and approved PFDs are available for your race.

All Access paddlers requiring adaptive equipment should contact registrar@dragonboatbc.ca to ensure that the Festival can provide support during the race.

Roster Qualifications

Gender Categories

Mixed: Minimum of 10 female paddlers, and maximum of 10 male paddlers (Note: deviation from IDBF Rule. A team with 13 female and 7 male paddlers can race in Mixed).

Women's: All female racers including drummer and steers.

Open: No gender restrictions.

Age Categories: Age category racers may be required to present identification to prove their age. Junior: Paddlers and drummer at least 12 years old but under 19 on December 31, 2017. U24: Racers at least 12 years old but under 24 on December 31, 2017. Two racers per roster are allowed to be over 23 but under of 26 on December 31, 2017.











Senior: Paddlers and drummer over 59 on December 31, 2017.

Premier: All racers at least 19 years old (division name changed to match IDBF rules, formerly Adult). Racers under 19 may be approved on a case by case basis by the Race Director through the Race Registrar (registrar@dragonboatbc.ca).

General Notes

All teams must have a team manager over the age of 19 who is not necessarily listed as a racer on the team roster as well as a team captain who is listed as a racer on the team roster.

All divisions can have a maximum of 26 racers on their roster plus 1 team manager, except for Junior teams. Junior teams can have a maximum of 30 racers on their roster plus 1 team manager.

All boats must carry at least 16 paddlers at a minimum.

Concord Pacific Dragon Boat Festival Divisional and Event Summary

Racers may only paddle for one team in a single division, but may steer/drum for multiple teams within that same division.

While being rostered in multiple divisions is common, the Festival will not hold the race schedule to accommodate racers that race in multiple divisions. It is the team's duty to ensure their racers are available to be marshalled and checked at least 30 minutes prior to their race time.

Race Rosters, Waivers, and Race Packages

Managers are responsible for ensuring racers complete their waivers before their first race, and can send out waivers for racers over 19 online through <u>register.dragonboatbc.ca</u>. Racers under 19 cannot do their waivers online: visit www.vancouverdragonboatfestival.ca/downloads to print a paper waiver. Managers must submit a roster to the Race Registrar before their first race. Visit <u>register.dragonboatbc.ca</u> to sign in and access the template. All racers must be listed on the roster.











For the Festival, teams must visit the Race Registrar during published times or at the Tim Hortons 500 Championship (June 9-10) to trade in their Rosters and Waivers for the race package containing racer wristbands, team parking pass (one per team), and other important information.

Racer's Village

Access to Racer's Village will be only granted to those with Racer or Team Official wristbands. Due to construction, Racer's Village is expected to be West of the 2017 location in the lot between Concord Pacific and Plaza of Nations. Updates will be available in future Bulletins.

Teams will be assigned a tent space. Tents should not exceed 10X10. Please note that tents are only automatically provided to All Access teams. International/Out of Province/Out of Town teams may book tents free of charge through the forms at the end of Bulletin 1.
